

- Long list book prizes: 143♂ 56우
- Short list book prizes: 41♂ 19♀
- Gap in publishing program: 25%-30% on average
- Advisory board and jury members in the literature section: 61%♂ 39%♀


To this end, all literary reviews of fiction from the newspapers

Der Standard, Die Presse, Falter, Die Furche, and Wiener Zeitung from 2022 were analysed






